For more than 20 years he has advised people in many cultures and settings on how to resolve conflict, improve their working relationships and enhance the quality of their lives. He is a regular presenter at conferences in the UK and abroad, and over 200,000 people have attended his seminars and presentations. He is author of three books, the latest of which, *Solution Focused Brief Therapy for the Helping Professions*, will be published Summer 2010.
